Annual Outdoor Concert Returns to RAM's Charles A. Wustum Museum of Fine Arts

Racine, WI July 10, 2024

An annual collaboration between Mahogany Gallery and the Racine Art Museum (RAM)—two contemporary art spaces in Racine, Wisconsin—returns to the verdant gardens at RAM's Charles A. Wustum Museum of Fine Arts (Wustum), 2519 Northwestern Avenue, on Thursday, July 25. *Groov'n in the Garden 2024* is an unforgettable celebration of local music that promises soulful melodies, infectious beats, and a vibrant atmosphere.

The grounds at Wustum open at 5:00 pm with a local DJ spinning lively beats in the background as concertgoers set up their seating—attendees must bring their own lawn chairs or picnic blankets. Kicking off the musical extravaganza at 6:00 pm, the VersaTile Band will take the stage to unleash an infusion of rhythm and blues, neo-soul, and a dose of funk throughout two sets.

Food and beverages will be available to purchase throughout the evening, but attendees are welcome to bring their own food if they prefer. Delectable southern comfort bites from Ed's Taste of Soul, a food vendor in Racine, will be served from their food truck. Chicago-based Moor's Brewing Company will offer a selection of finely crafted brews that "pay homage to the rich untold history of [the brewers'] African ancestry and the 'Original Craftsmen' that made it happen." Additionally, Tito's Handmade Vodka will provide liquor and mixers for two specialty cocktails—one inspired by Wustum's landscape and another inspired by the music.
