Thank you for your support of **Racine Art Museum** throughout 2014! Your gifts helped this museum continue on its mission to serve the people of this community, the region, and the national fine arts field. RAM has become a leader in promoting contemporary crafts artists, making Racine a required stop for anyone interested in creativity and lifelong learning. The museum's nationally recognized exhibitions and education programs serve people of all ages thanks to you. RAM is also grateful to the hundreds of volunteers who donated their time to champion programs at both campuses last year. Each of you helped make 2014 truly a banner year.

RAM posted a **20% increase** in visitors over 2013. Just short of 60,000, this was the largest annual audience in the museum's history! Attendance for all programs was up, but there were significant increases in studio art class enrollments, *RAM on the Road*, and *SPARK* programs. In addition, the public's response to RAM's museum-wide show of ceramics from the collection, held in conjunction with a national clay conference (NCECA) in Milwaukee, brought thousands of people into the galleries. This influx was back-to-back with last spring's popular **5th Annual International PEEPS Art Exhibition** to top off a busy, buzzing season. And happily, the excitement continued throughout the year.

RAM has dual roles as a cultural institution and a tourist attraction, drawing visitors from around the region to Racine. This is validated by guest statistics: 38% of the museum's visitors in 2014 came from outside Wisconsin—representing 47 different US states and 21 countries. In recognition of these efforts, RAM was honored to receive the **Wisconsin Governor's Tourism Award for Arts, Culture, and Heritage** in March 2015. This award recognized RAM as the destination that best showcases arts and culture while enhancing tourism and contributing to the economic well-being of their community.

The best way to thank you is to show you. In this issue of **Focus: RAM**, you will learn more about the programs that your contributions make possible and see the great things that RAM has planned for the rest of 2015. Sub-Culture Craft reveals the intersection of art with cultural subjects that inspire devoted “fan” followings. This exhibition specifically addresses the science-fiction and fantasy-based themes of **Doctor Who**, **Star Wars**, **steampunk**, and **superheroes**.

Focusing on work directly inspired by these themes, or by the winding of these kinds of topics in and out of popular culture, this show features a variety of objects and images. Whether carved wood reliefs of characters from *Doctor Who*, a **30-foot-long cross-stitch tapestry** of the *Star Wars* saga, steampunk jewelry, ensembles and jetpacks, or knit superhero costumes, the work delights and impresses.

Those whose works are represented in this exhibition emphasize the value of the handmade, combining their skills and imagination with compelling stories and characters drawn from or inspired by modern science fiction, fantasy, history, and invented worlds. **Fans of pop culture** generally or in specific areas, these individuals create work that reflects the dynamism of contemporary creativity.

Primarily drawn from RAM’s collection, **All in the Family: Featuring Kelly and Kyle Phelps** showcases the work of families of artists—couples, parents and children, and siblings. This exhibition suggests how shared environments might shape the creative process. What similarities may exist generationally, as visible through works of art? Whether or not artists are creating collaboratively, it is interesting to consider how they may affect one another’s working processes or sources for ideas.

Perhaps surprisingly, RAM’s collection includes a large amount of artworks by people who are connected through intimate circumstances such as marriage or bloodline. **All in the Family** presents examples of their work side-by-side and raises questions about how artists are influenced, especially at home.

This show features a concentration of collaborative

sculptural work borrowed from emerging artists **Kelly and Kyle Phelps**. The Phelps are African-American twin brothers whose work addresses the complex role of the middle class in contemporary society. Drawing on their own blue collar upbringing in a Midwestern factory town, they explore the “plight” of the anonymous laborer through **gritty, visceral reliefs and small-scale sculpture**. Working together, the artists build narratives that combine socio-political topics regarding race and class with personal memory and experience.

Conversation in the Studio

Curator of Exhibitions
Lena Vigna Speaks
with RAM Artist
Fellowship Recipient
Jim Sincock



Vigna: Please share the basics of your art career thus far. How long have you been a part of the Racine/Kenosha community?

Sincock: I trained in fine art photography in the mid-eighties at Milwaukee Center for Photography and Milwaukee Institute of Art & Design. I exhibited a little bit during that time, but got distracted with commercial photography as a business. Around 2000, I began focusing on my art again and getting into the occasional group exhibit, but really didn't try to make it a full-time pursuit until 2012. I was involved in the Kenosha art community for a few years in the mid-eighties when I ran the former Gallery 124 (now Anderson Arts Center). I later lived in Milwaukee for several years, and then Boulder, Colorado. In the fall of 2013, I moved back to Wisconsin and started to look into the Racine & Kenosha art community once again.

Vigna: Would you please describe your work—what materials you use, what subject matters do you explore?

Sincock: My work is an introspective and meditative look at landscapes, both natural and manmade. I also create dreamlike still-life scenes. The depiction of quiet places, both physical and imaginary, is a recurring theme in my work. It is also about seeing the unseen; most of my pieces depict places most people would walk by without noticing.

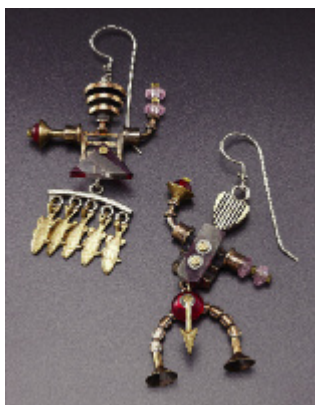
