A Note About Giving from Director of Operations and Development Laura D'Amato As you may know, RAM recently completed a very thorough and intense Planning and Sustainability Study with The North Group, Inc., New York. Beginning in January 2011, Halsey and Alice North worked with the museum's Board and staff to develop some short- and long-term initiatives to help maximize resources and build a more sustainable business model. This is especially pertinent in a time when museums across the country are closing at an alarming rate due to lack of funding and a lingering poor economy.

The most crucial initiative is the strengthening of our fundraising capacity. There have been some major staff adjustments and reorganization of responsibilities in order to more strongly focus on fundraising and revenue building. RAM is totally dependent on gifts from individuals, corporations,



foundations, planned gifts, and bequests to fund all aspects of operations. We are fortunate and grateful to many of you for your support in building a healthy endowment that provides dividends and accumulated earnings to supplement our fundraising efforts. However, that is not a long-term, sustainable business model, so we have to work even harder to raise funds in order to be viable in the future.

This spring marked the first time that all the museum's galleries have been devoted to one medium. This tasty visual buffet of four separate exhibitions presented 50 loans and over 150 pieces from



the collection, including **Toshiko Takaezu's** masterwork, **The Star Series**. These exhibitions were organized as part of our participation in the National Council on Education for the Ceramic Arts (NCECA) conference held in Milwaukee in March.

Since 1966, NCECA has worked to advance the national ceramics field. The 2014 conference drew over 5,000 attendees to Milwaukee, many of whom toured the related exhibitions at venues throughout the region. This was an opportunity for museums and galleries in the area to showcase all the amazing destinations in Southeastern Wisconsin to experience contemporary ceramics.

Based on the glowing feedback we heard throughout the week, RAM rose to the top of the selections. During the run of NCECA, over 1,200 people toured the stunning exhibitions at the museum, sharing hundreds of photos with their friends and encouraging colleagues to visit. RAM's curatorial staff also organized a collection exhibition onsite at the conference within the Wisconsin Center—the first time a museum has brought a show to NCECA—that attracted an additional 2,326 people!

In addition to hosting specialized tours at RAM for conference attendees, collection focus artist **Sergei Isupov** visited twice to speak and autograph the study guide published to accompany his exhibition here (free to RAM members). His career survey, on display at the museum through early June, is drawn from the museum's holdings and has received substantial media coverage online and in print.

To top it off, the Racine Art Museum Store organized MUD, a show of Midwestern potters to encourage new collectors (described later in this publication). Multiple generations of ceramists and collectors filled RAM for a week with their thrilled responses.

RAM's goal was to introduce our impressive collection—as well as the museum's commitment to ceramics—to a broad national and international audience, including



guests from Great Britain, Belgium, and Taiwan, while demonstrating to our local and regional supporters the countless ways this incredibly versatile medium can be utilized. Visit RAM soon to experience the work by Sergei Isupov and the glimmering pieces in White Gold: The Appeal of Lustre.

Leaving A Legacy to RAM

Meet Artist Philip Fike

Philip Fike was born in Baraboo, Wisconsin in 1927 and received his BS and MS from the University of Wisconsin-Madison. He was a career-long art jeweler and a highly respected university instructor.

Much of Fike's work concentrated on brooch-like pins, called *fibulae*, which were worn by the



ancient Greeks and Romans. He was instrumental in reviving this form of jewelry during the twentieth century.

In January 2013, RAM was notified that Fike had very thoughtfully remembered both his family and RAM in his estate plans. At that time, we learned that he had passed away in 1997 and bequeathed part of his estate to a relative with instructions that upon her death, any remaining funds were to be given to RAM.

In June 2013, Madison-area glass sculptor, Audrey Handler, approached RAM and offered the museum one of Fike's *fibulae*, which became the first example of his work to enter our collection. His piece will likely be included in a show of recent acquisitions in 2015.

Fike's thoughtful estate planning is a perfect example of how loved ones can be provided for first, and RAM can be a secondary or "remainder" beneficiary. Even five or ten percent of your estate plans will go a long way toward ensuring the museums' future while leaving your legacy in the community. We honor Philip Fike for his contributions to the field and thank him for his generosity and thoughtfulness.

Exhibitions Preview

Exploring Storytelling at RAM and Wustum with Curator of Exhibitions Lena Vigna



This summer, Racine Art Museum explores the dynamics of visual storytelling through images and objects. Storytelling is a fundamental facet of human existence. No matter the form. the capacity and necessity of sharing and communicating through stories extends through time and space. Whether referencing known and beloved fairy tales, crafting tales of their own, or creating works that feature engaging characters, the artists whose works are presented offer a myriad of opportunities to let your imagination soar. This theme

offers numerous exciting programming opportunities including *Telling Tales: RAM Community Art Exhibition*, book readings, and as inspiration for the **Royal Affair**, this year's RAM fundraising event in Wustum's gardens on **Saturday, August 9**.

The first exhibition to open in the series, *Once Upon A Time: Fairy Tales, Fantasy, and Contemporary Art*, features artists that use a variety of media and techniques to craft stories that emphasize the human condition through exaggerated, surreal, perplexing, imaginative, or dreamy scenarios that are rooted in the traditions of fairy tales, legends, and myths. For example, *Patty Grazini* creates paper sculptures of historical criminals imagined as animals and *David Walters'* glass vessels and forms are emblazoned with cautionary stories told through characters from children's stories and fairy tales.
