## Supply List

These are the supplies that the instructor uses but participants should feel free to use whatever they are comfortable with.

**Paper**: The instructor favors *Arches* 140 lb. or 300 lb. 22" x 30" sheets. These can be sized as desired. Participants can use whatever paper they are comfortable with.

**Paints:** I mostly use Daniel Smith\* or M. Graham# transparent or semi-transparent paints. The colors you will typically find on my palette include:

- Aureolin\*
- Raw Sienna#
- Burnt Sienna\*
- Quinacridone Gold\*
- Quinacridone Burnt Orange\*
- Sap Green\*
- Deep Sap Green\*

- Ultramarine\*
- Cerulean\*
- Cobalt\*
- Manganese\*
- Quinacridone Rose#
- Perylene Maroon#

## Brushes:

- Flat Brush 3/4" or 1"
- Synthetic Brushes
  - o Silver velvet rounds: size 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16
  - o Silver velvet 1" oval
- Hake Brushes 1", 2", 3"

## Miscellaneous

- 2 large containers for water
- Paper Towel
- Spray bottle
- Pencil
- Kneaded Eraser
- Artist's Tape
- Pebo masking fluid
- Watercolor palette or butcher tray
