### Art for Peeps' sake

The clean, quiet galleries of an art museum aren't typically conducive to sugary snacks.

For the third year in a row, however, the Racine Art Museum, 441 Main St., Racine, will present its untraditional exhibit of fluffy, neon-colored, sugar-encrusted, marshmallow Peeps-inspired art.

Entries were accepted from artists of all ages in what RAM says is the only museum competition of its kind on the planet. A panel of connoisseurs will judge the confectionary artworks, made from the bunny- and chick-shaped treats that are ubiquitous around the Easter holiday, for the Annual International Peeps Exhibition. In the first two years, the show has attracted big crowds.

An opening reception for the Peeps show with \$5 admission will be held from 5:30 to 7:30 p.m. Thursday; it includes an awards ceremony. The exhibit opens to the public at 10 a.m. Friday; admission is free on the first Friday of the month.

The Peeps exhibit runs through April 22 and is included in regular museum admission: \$5 adults, \$3 seniors and students; free for ages 11 and younger.
