RACINE — The Wustum Museum exhibit “Sci-Fi, Superheroes and Steampunk: RAM Community Art Exhibition” showcases innovative artwork created by RAM students, instructors, Racine Art Guild members, Racine school teachers and museum staff. The exhibit will be on display until Aug. 15.
